

# Chimay Triple

- **Taste** : Subtle combination of fresh hops and yeast that is improved by a bitter touch.
- **Type of foam** : Fine and snowy.
- **Alcohol content** : 8% alcohol by volume
- **Country**: Belgium



The Chimay Triple, last-born of the Abbey, is labelled “Cinq Cents” on the 750 ml bottle. Of a golden colour, the Trappist beer combines sweet and bitter in a rare balance. The beer’s aroma felt in the mouth comes from the hops’ perfumes: above

all, they are fruity touches of Muscat grapes and raisins, even ripe apples. This traditional Belgian beer is best savoured fresh at a temperature of from 6 to 8°C.
